Let us continue to rise to the challenge of ensuring our seniors ongoing food security and independence at home. Together we can make a difference in the lives of our friends and neighbors, affecting the entire community. Donations for this cause must be received from March 1st to April 30th. The donations can be cash or checks. If you choose to write a check, make it out to the Gibson Nutrition Program and write on the memo line: "Go Green". Please respond as soon as possible so all donations are received by Apr. 30. As usual Gibson will keep all monies.

We are serving approximately 85 Meals on Wheels a day, in addition to our daily Congregate meal. We thank you for considering this appeal and for your past assistance and ongoing partnership in supporting the mission of the Gibson Center.
