Our vision is that citizens of all ages can say they would rather live here than anywhere else. Towards this

end we are using the framework of the AARP Network of Age-Friendly communities which is itself an affiliate of the World Health Organization's plan to help cities prepare for rapid population aging. 
Thursday the 14th: There will be a Sing-a-Long after lunch, featuring Irish music and humor.
